<b>3</b>	<b>Minimum GPA</b>	2.0 minimum GPA	CSU: 2.5 (recommended) <i>refer to eligibility index</i> UC: 3.3 <i>(competitive GPA is much higher)</i> <b>*CSU/UC GPA includes all grades earned in "a-g" courses summer before 10<sup>th</sup> through summer following 11<sup>th</sup>.</b>	2.3 minimum GPA <i>Grades lock end of second semester of junior year</i>
<b>4</b>	<b>Other</b>	230 credits	Must take SAT/ACT no later than December of senior year. CSU: SAT (essay not required) or ACT (writing portion not required). UC: SAT with essay or ACT plus writing. <b>*SAT Subject test only required for certain majors.</b>	Must also meet Div I & II Sliding Scale Index. For Division I, 10 core courses must be completed before the start of 12 <sup>th</sup> grade.
